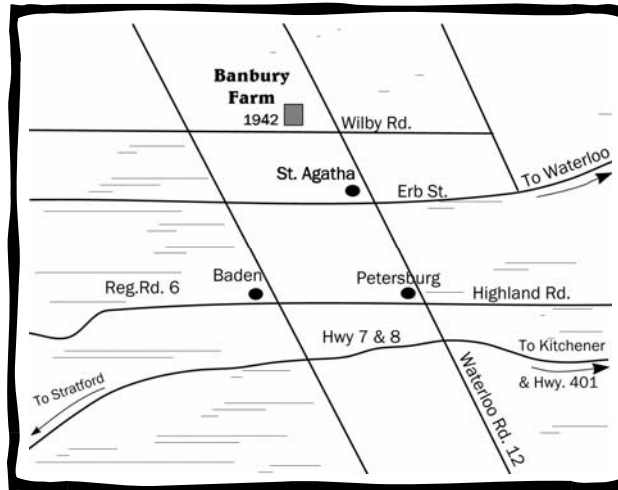

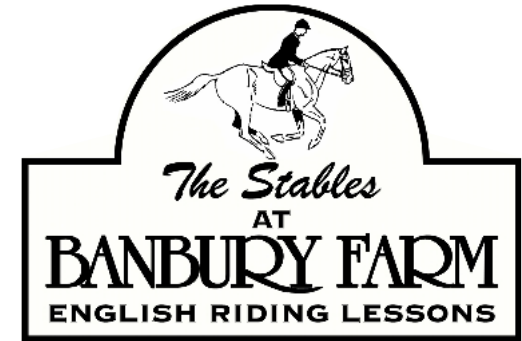


How to find Banbury Farm

Year Round Riding Lessons

Riding lessons are available on an ongoing basis for students of all ages and abilities — from beginner to advanced, 5 years old to adult. Lessons can be arranged privately or in small groups.

Beginner riders are started privately on the longe line. (A longe line is a long rope by which the instructor controls the horse.) This is the safest way for a novice rider to learn.

Our facilities include both indoor and outdoor arenas, jumping facilities, and acres of trails. Limited boarding and co-boarding are available.

Qualified instructors and well-schooled horses and ponies ensure a positive riding experience.
